(See list opposite). ELECTION OF WOMEN TO BRANCH CONFERENCE The rules of the branch provide that the minimum number of women to be elected shall be 50 per cent of the number of persons to be elected from each region. If the number of persons to be elected is an odd number, the minimum number of women to be elected shall be determined by reducing the total number of persons to be elected by one and taking 50 per cent of that number. If the number of women candidates is less than the number of women to be elected, the remaining position or positions in question will be filled by a male candidate or candidates. NOMINATIONS , which must be in writing and comply with the Rules of the union, may be made anytime from 13 February 2012. They must reach me not later than 12:00 noon on Friday, 16 March 2012 .
