This presentation explores how decolonising the classroom and incorporating First Nations contexts can contribute to supporting the outcomes of all students. It provides a practical approach that can begin to overcome colonisation, embrace and celebrate diversity, and ensure success for all.

Keynote speaker: Belinda Webb

Belinda Webb is an Education Support Specialist at Covenant College, currently working to support families and teachers working with students with disabilities or additional needs. Belinda is a trained Special Education Teacher and has held roles as a Behaviour Coach and Behaviour Consultant.

This presentation will provide practical strategies to develop your skills in working with students with diverse learning needs and/or learning disabilities, with a particular focus on ASD and ADHD.
