2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a statement to be included with ballot material. This statement may not exceed 200 words and can include a passport-sized photo. The material may include an indication of preference provided all candidates are shown in the order they appear on the ballot paper and there is a preference allocated to each candidate. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 5.00pm AEST on 22/09/2023 can be accepted.

Scrutineer Appointment

Candidates may appoint a Scrutineer, being a financial member of the Organisation and not a current candidate for any office in this election, to represent them. A Scrutineer Appointment form is available from the Returning Officer.
