A nomination form is available for electronic completion on the AEC Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/. However, the nomination form must then be lodged in accordance with the Organisation's rules (see below).

Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) **on** 03/06/2022.

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

4. The subject line of the email should include the reference: '**E2021/199 RECALL Nomination – your name**'.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 10/06/2022.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a statement to be distributed with the ballot material, statements shall be restricted to a maximum of 200 words and may include a passport size photograph. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00pm (Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)) on 10/06/2022 can be accepted. Statements should be provided in MS Word format and may be emailed to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au.

Election of women to Branch Conference

The rules of the branch provide that the minimum number of women to be elected shall be 50 per cent of the number of persons to be elected from each region. If the number of persons to be elected is an odd number, the minimum number of women to be elected shall be determined by reducing the total number of persons to be elected by one and taking 50 per cent of that number. If the number of women candidates is less than the number of women to be elected, the remaining position or positions in question will be filled by a male candidate or candidates.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 24/06/2022 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 22/07/2022.

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers closes 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 22/07/2022.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
