Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after **12 noon AEDT on 21/02/2019.**

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a candidate statement of no more than 200 words and a passport sized photograph to be included with ballot material. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by **12 noon AEDT on 28/02/2019** can be accepted.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 25/03/2019 and close at 12 noon AEDT on 12/04/2019.

Scrutineers

Candidates may appoint a scrutineer. Scrutineers must be a financial member of the Union. The appointment of scrutineers and closes at 12 noon AEDT on 12/04/2019.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
