## Resolution – Special Joint Primary and Secondary Sector Council, 4 February 2022

## Victorian Government Schools Agreement 2022

That the Joint Primary and Secondary Sector Council recommends to members the endorsement of the proposed Victorian Government Schools Agreement 2022 and the associated improvements.

Accordingly Joint Primary and Secondary Sector Council authorises the cessation of the industrial bans, which are currently suspended.

Joint Primary and Secondary Sector Council endorses the following ratification process:

- 1. Ratification meetings will be held in the three weeks commencing Monday 28 February 2022.
- The sub-branch delegate entitlement for voting will be one (1) delegate for every twenty (20) financial members (or part thereof) in the sub-branch.
- 3. One delegate will be appointed by each sub-branch to cast their sub-branch vote(s) at one ratification meeting only.
- 4. The requisite number of voting cards for each sub-branch will be provided to delegates at their ratification meeting.
- 5. The resolution put to the meeting will be,

## "That the proposed Victorian Government Schools Agreement 2022, and associated improvements be endorsed".

That question shall be put without amendment. Delegates can lodge a vote either for or against that resolution by casting their voting cards in the ballot boxes provided.

- 6. At each delegates meeting the votes for and against the resolution shall be tallied and reported to the Branch Secretary. Subsequent to the meeting, the voting cards cast for and against shall be forwarded in separate bundles to the Branch Secretary.
- 7. The outcome of the ratification process will be determined by the combined votes of delegates from each meeting and shall be binding on the Union.

In addition:

- a bulletin be sent to all schools members informing them of the Joint Primary and Secondary Sector Council meeting decision and outlining key elements of the proposed agreement and associated improvements.
- That the proposed agreement and associated improvements, and any related information be posted on the AEU website <u>www.aeuvic.asn.au</u> as soon as possible.
- That the ratification meeting timetable, commencing Monday 28 February 2022, including details of dates, times and locations, will be forwarded to sub-branch representatives and posted on the AEU website as soon as it is finalised.
