A nomination form is available for electronic completion on the AEC Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/. However, the nomination form must then be lodged in accordance with the Organisation's rules (see below).

Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00 Noon Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) **on** 10/03/2023.

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

The subject line for the email should read: "E2022/204 AEU VIC - Nomination [Insert name]"

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.
3. You may call 03 9285 7111 to enquire about the status of your nomination.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00 Noon Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 10/03/2023.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a statement to be included with ballot material. The material may include:

- A statement with a **maximum** of 200 words per candidate;
- **may** include a passport size photograph and
- **may** include an indication of preference provided all candidates are shown in the order they appear on the ballot paper and there is a preference allocated to each candidate.

Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00 Noon (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 17/03/2023 can be accepted.

Statements should be provided in MS Word format and may be emailed to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

Election of women to Branch Conference

The rules of the branch provide that the minimum number of women to be elected shall be 50 per cent of the number of persons to be elected from each region. If the minimum number of persons to be elected is an odd number, the minimum number of women to be elected shall be determined by reducing the total number of persons to be elected by one and taking 50 per cent of that number. If the number of women candidates is less than the number of women to be elected, the remaining position or positions in question will be filled by a male candidate or candidates.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 29/03/2023 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 26/04/2023.

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers opens 03/02/2023 and closes 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 26/04/2023.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
